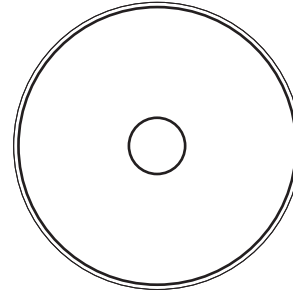


CD, DVD, Blu-ray & USB/Flash Drive FACE ART

Please provide artwork for all CD, DVD, Blu-ray & USB/Flash Drive face art by following the instructions Below. Artwork provided in a different format than requested may be subject to additional cost for art/prepress time.



- Supply the following files for your artwork:

1. High Resolution Adobe PDF (.pdf) print ready file
(this is the file we will print from)

2. Native art files used to create the PDF i.e. Adobe Illustrator (.ai), Photoshop (.psd), InDesign (.idd), or Quark (.qxd) files
(Native files will be used to make minor corrections if needed and could be subject to additional cost)

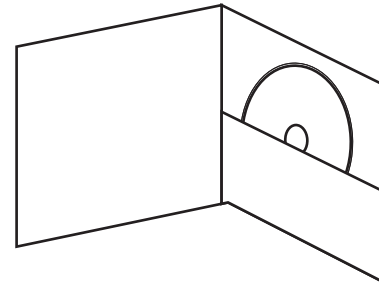
- All artwork should be submitted at a minimum of 300 dpi, at printing size and created utilizing a CDFX art template.
- Design all artwork to center and edges. Do not cut out center hole or around outer edges.
- Define all color modes as CMYK or PMS. (i.e. NO RGB files)
- All fonts must be included, or text converted to outlines.
- Artwork elements in native files should be placed on separate layers. (i.e. do NOT flatten templates or dyelines within your files)

Please Remember!

- Gradients higher than 85% or lower than 15% may not print clearly (only applies to Silk Screen printing).
- Text under 6pt. Arial Bold in size cannot be guaranteed to print clearly.
- Colors may vary in printing processes; should your artwork need to match, please supply CDFX with a printed sample or Pantone colors for matching
- Other file formats we accept but could require additional cost for artwork/prepress time are Jpeg (.jpg) or TIFF (.tif)

Print/Packaging Artwork

Please provide artwork for all CD, DVD or Blu-ray packaging art by following the instructions below. Artwork provided in a different format than requested may be subject to additional cost for art/prepress time.



- Supply the following files for your artwork:

1. High Resolution Adobe PDF (.pdf) print ready file
(this is the file we will print from)

2. Native art files used to create the PDF i.e. Adobe Illustrator (.ai), Photoshop (.psd), InDesign (.idd), or Quark (.qxd) files
(Native files will be used to make minor corrections if needed and could be subject to additional cost)

- All artwork should be submitted at a minimum of 300 dpi, at printing size and created utilizing a CDFX art template.
- All artwork must contain at least 1/8th inch bleed as specified in templates.
- Define all color modes as CMYK. (i.e. NO RGB files) PMS colors used in artwork may require additional printing cost.
- All fonts must be included, or text converted to outlines.
- Artwork elements in native files should be placed on separate layers. (i.e. do NOT flatten templates or dyelines within your files)

Please Remember!

- Text under 5pt. Bold in size cannot be guaranteed to print clearly.
- Colors may vary in printing processes; should your artwork need to match, please supply CDFX with a printed sample or Pantone colors for matching.
- Other file formats we accept but could require additional cost for artwork/prepress time are Jpeg (.jpg) or TIFF (.tif).
